

Council Replacement Elections on February 24



2nd & 3rd Degree Ceremony at Council 284

Twenty-five candidates from six of the 10 English councils in districts 60 and 91 in the Montréal area advanced to the third degree in an afternoon ceremony hosted by Montréal Council 284 at the Foundation of Catholic Community Services building at the corner of de Maisonneuve boulevard and St. Marc street in Montréal on Sunday, February 10, 2013. The newly advanced members were then knighted by the respective district deputies, SK Tom Altenburg and SK Boris Polanski, under the auspices of newly certified conferring officer SK Joe Labelle.



Council 13881 elected a new slate of officers in a replacement election held on February 24, 2013. SK Peter Araneta was elected as grand knight, SK Rey Nacino as deputy grand knight, SK Marietto Tolentino as treasurer, SK Art Cortez as chancellor, SK Marison Callanta as recorder, SK Silvestre Pimentel as advocate, Rommel Medina as alternate inside guard, and Benito Soliven as trustee for a three year term. All candidates were elected by acclamation. District 91 deputy SK Boris Polanski acted as election chairman, fraternal counselor SK John Casey acted as election secretary and SK Patrick Gotera acted as the election scrutineer. The newly elected officers will serve until the end of the 2012-2013 fraternal year with regularly scheduled elections to be held on May 26, 2013.

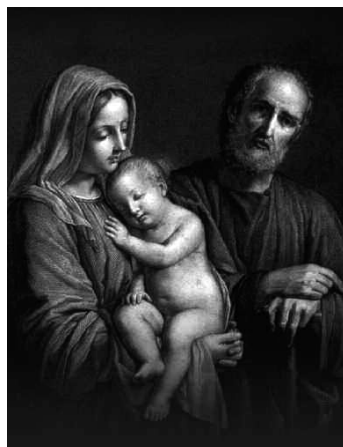


Knights sponsor two RCIA candidates

Sponsors are fully initiated practicing Catholics.

Year of Faith Prayer Cards

In his Apostolic Letter Porta Fidei, Pope Benedict XVI expressed his desire that during the Year of Faith "we will have the opportunity to profess our faith in the Risen Lord in our cathedrals and in the churches of the whole world, in our homes and among our families, so that everyone may feel a strong need to know better and to transmit to future generations the faith of all times". To foster the development of the faith "in our homes and among our families," Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori of Baltimore, authored a special prayer for families that is presented on A Family Prayer card (#10086). It is hoped that offering this prayer together with their children will help parents begin to fulfill the duty described by Pope John Paul II: "By reason of their dignity and mission, Christian parents have the specific responsibility of educating their children in prayer, introducing them to gradual discovery of the mystery of God and to personal dialogue with Him" (Familiaris Consortio, 60).
